Spring Mission Trip: The Ecumenical Mission Team formed in association with the Greater Fairmont Council of Churches in 2005 is planning a disaster relief mission trip to Southeastern Kentucky the week of March 12-17th. This in response to the devastating 1000 year flood event of July 2022 that hit the area that completely destroyed over a hundred homes and left thousands in the six county area unlivable. The group plans to travel to Letcher County with a focus of the work in and around Whitesburg. Participants must be at least 18 years of age and these dates were chosen to coincide with Spring Break at WVU in hopes that up to four students might be able participate. The size of the group is being limited to 12 persons. All people of faith are welcome. Housing and accommodations will be provided by a local group "Save His Sheep" working out of the former elementary school in Jenkins, KY which was renovated for this purpose. Letcher County has a Long Term Recovery Committee that will be helping with oversight and funding of the majority of building materials. The fee to participate in the trip is \$100 per person and we encourage those who cannot afford this to petition their congregation to help with it.
