“Laudato Si “ (Praise Be): St. Francis de Sales Catholic Parish (1 Guthrie Lane in Morgantown) will host a gathering in their Worship Space this Sunday, June 26th (1:30-2:30 pm) that will include music, discussion, and action that reflects on the Pope's encyclical, Laudato Si, relating to the climate crisis. The event will build on the church's call to be better and more active stewards of creation. Noted Catholic artist and member of Moms Clean Air Force, Lucia Valentine, will both play music and join a discussion with parishioner, Charles DiSalvo (moderator) and Fr.
